‘Mardi Gras for Homeless Children’ returns with a significant goal in mind

Over the last 29 years, the Northern Kentucky Restaurant Association has gathered local restaurants together on Mardi Gras with the goal to raise money for area homeless shelters. Their efforts have resulted in \$1,850,000 raised for homeless children throughout Greater Cincinnati. This year they’re planning to cross that \$2 million milestone, but they need your help.

This annual event is not your typical fundraiser. There will be auctions, celebrity attendees and live music, much like a standard charity event. What separates ‘Mardi Gras for Homeless Children’ is attendees’ opportunity to sample dishes and drinks from over 50 of the top local food and drink purveyors, with the understanding that all proceeds go towards fighting the homeless epidemic in our city.

The 29th annual culinary celebration will raise money for the Bethany House Services of Cincinnati, Brighton

Center’s Homeward Bound and the Welcome House of Northern Kentucky. Combined, these three shelters work to provide lodging, meals and more to over 7,000 greater Cincinnati residents. It is absolutely vital that we help support their admirable work.

Presented by Mercedes Benz of Fort Mitchell and the Wyler Foundation, the 29th annual celebration will be held once again at the Northern Kentucky Convention Center on February 25th at 6:30 PM. Individual tickets sell for either \$75 or \$95, with upper tier tickets granting early entrance to the fundraiser at 5:30 PM. 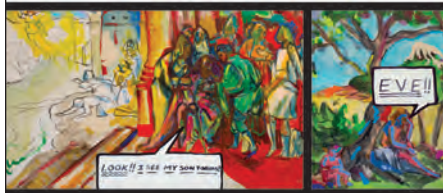

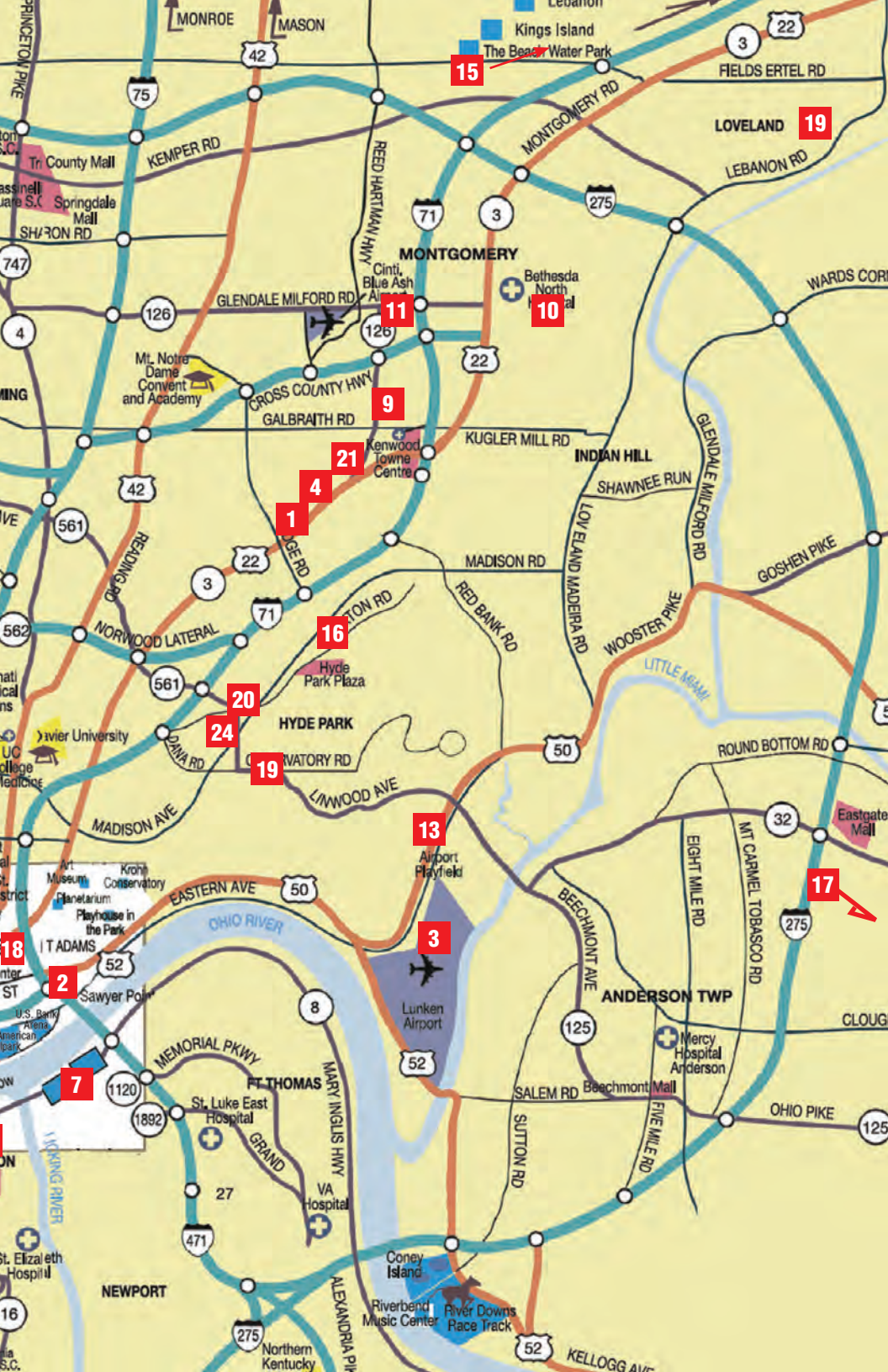

DOWNTOWN CINCINNATI AREA MAP

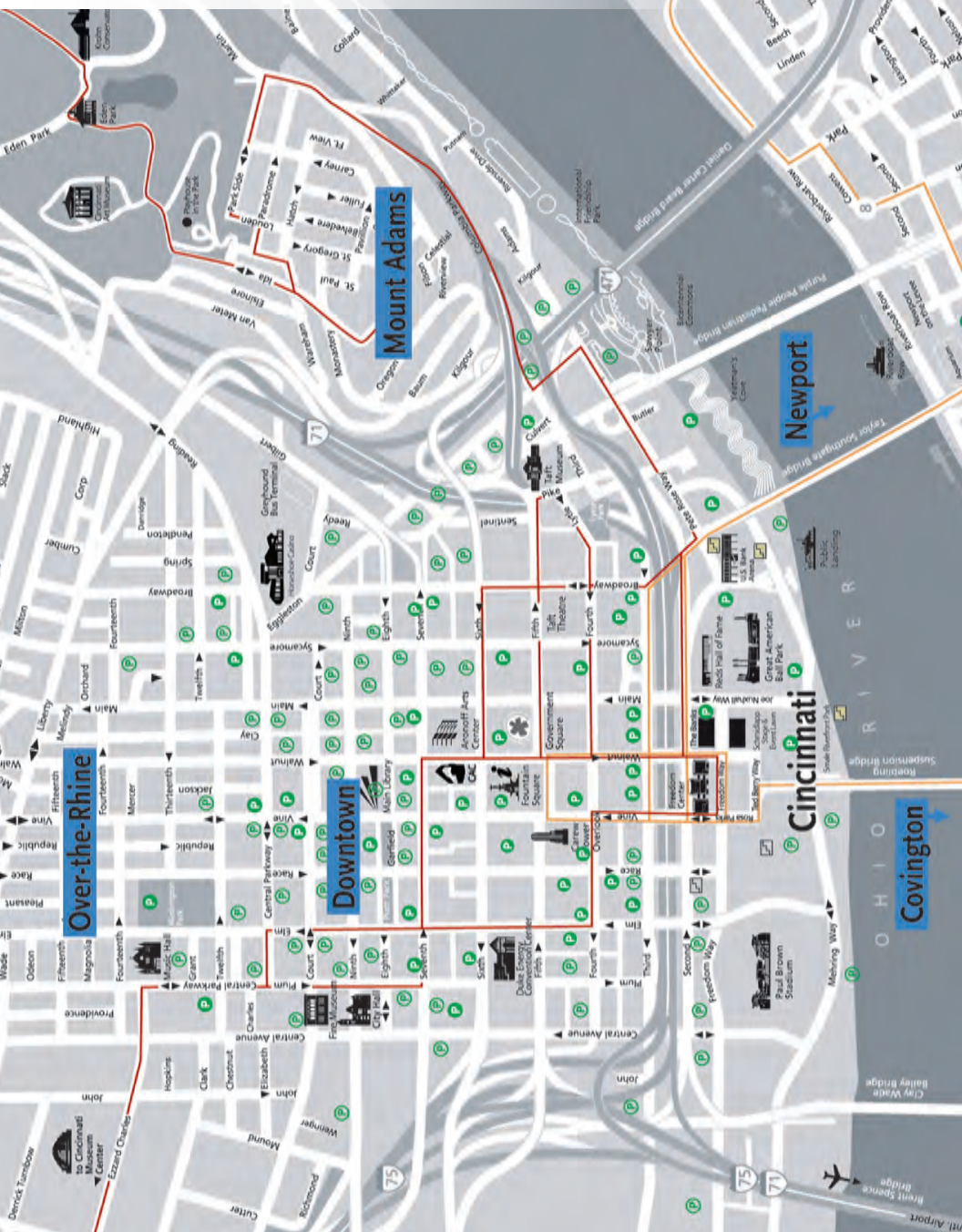

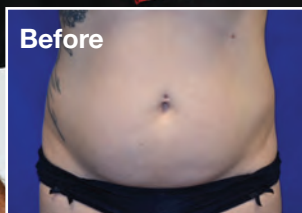

During a typical treatment, a small hand piece releases radiofrequency energy. This is placed over the targeted area and a small surrounding area. The energy causes fat cells to heat up and programs them to liquefy and be removed through the lymphatics after dying. 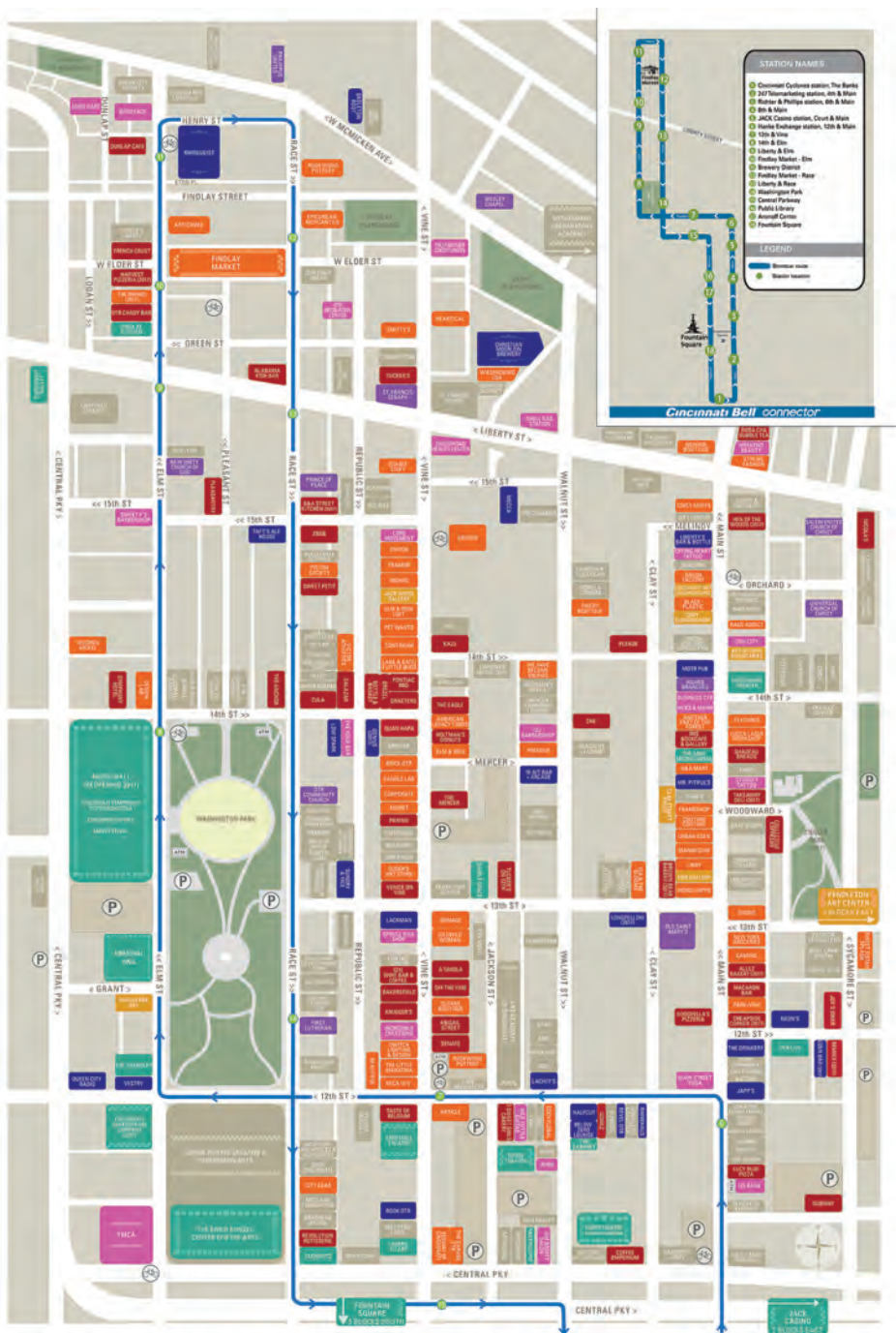
