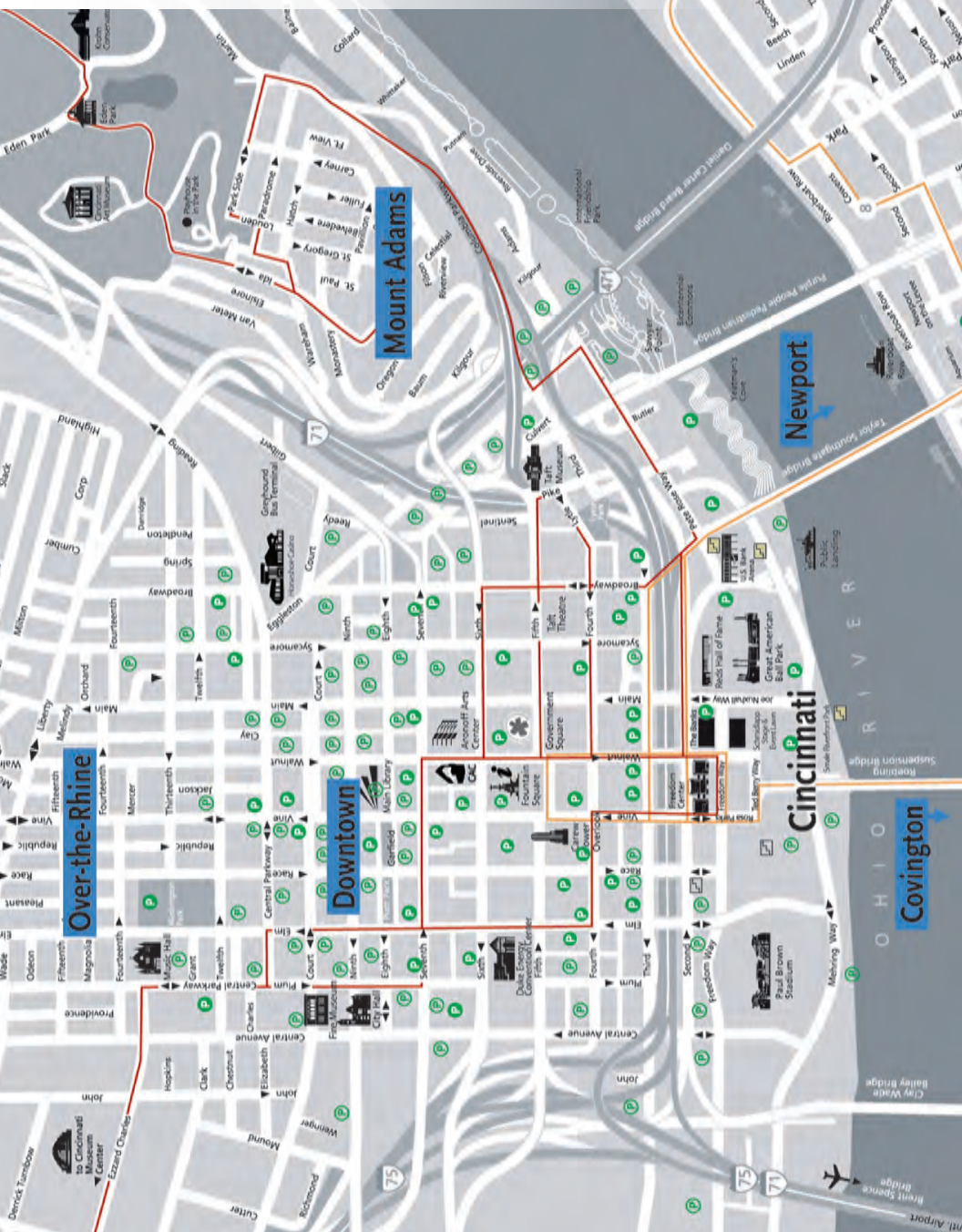








# DOWNTOWN CINCINNATI AREA MAP

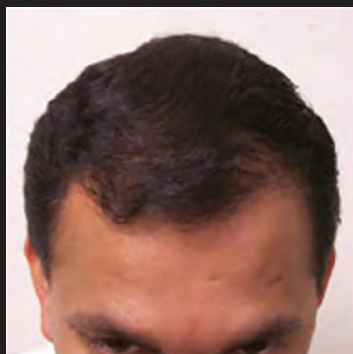

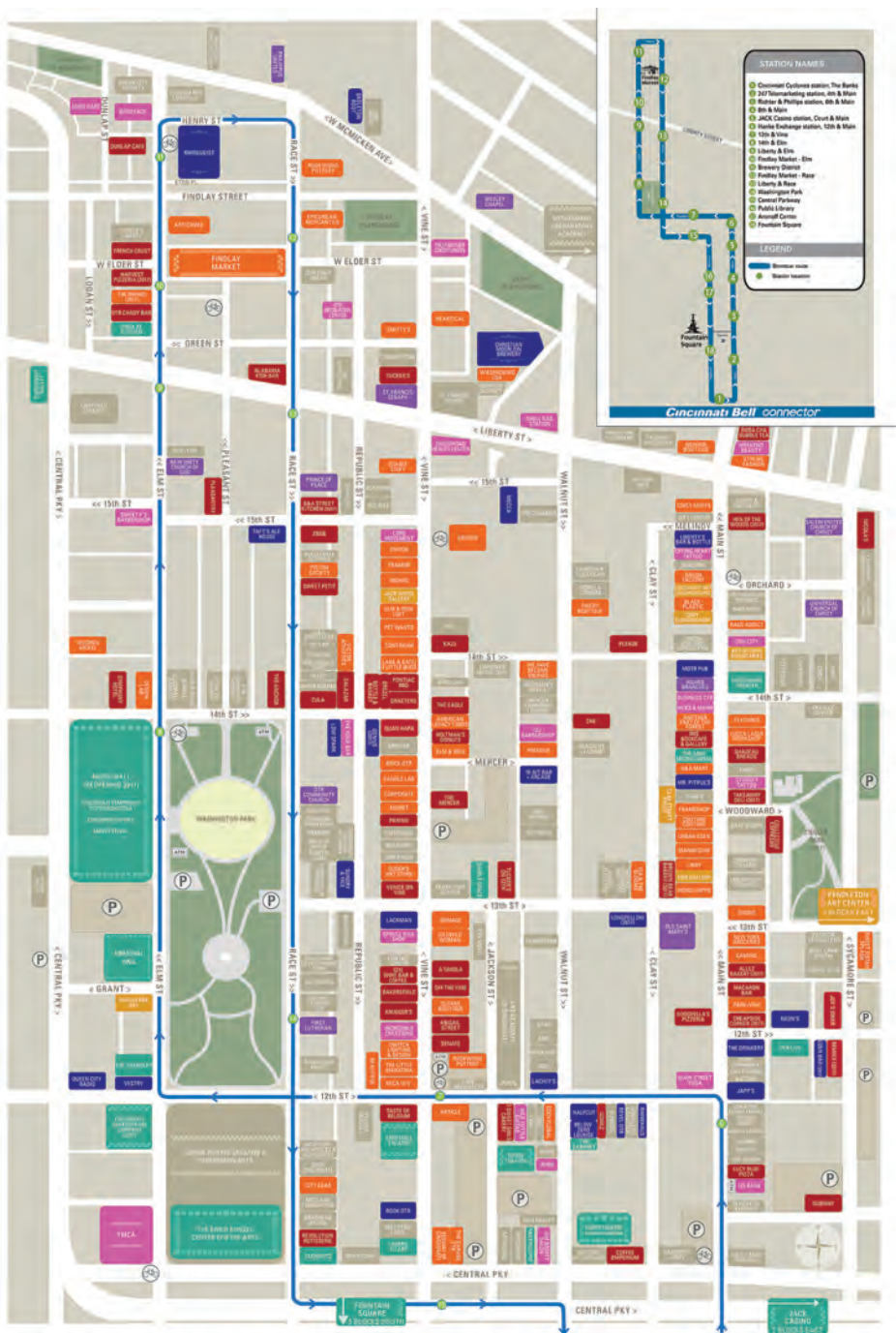


